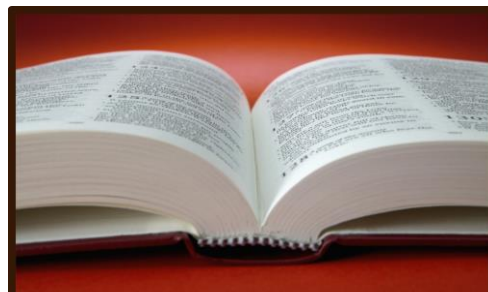

*"All that the LORD hath spoken we will do. And Moses returned the words of the people unto the LORD." Exodus 19:4-6,8*

Covenant is an agreement between two parties. The parties may be men or between God and man. God is keenly interested in covenant because it creates conditions of greater intimacy and closeness in His relationship with mankind. Even among men covenant families are best of friends. Covenant binds and makes relationship stronger. People do things they would not have ordinarily done as a result of covenant. Covenant takes relationship to a higher level and creates special privileges. God is interested in entering into covenant relationship with man, any man, so that He can bless them. History confirmed that every covenant of God or covenants with God are covenant of blessing provided we

keep to the terms of contract and agreement.

Typically all covenants involve (1) persons (2) agreement to be signed or sealed (3) witness or witnesses. It is very important that those entering into any covenant agreement should have adequate understanding of the persons with whom they are to have covenant and the terms and conditions set in the agreement.

Let's consider two subtopics:

1. Covenant keeping God
2. Covenant people of God.

### 1. Covenant keeping God

*“Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he is God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;” Deuteronomy 7:9*

*“My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips.” Psalms 89:34.*

God describe Himself as a covenant keeping God. That is, He is a God who is always faithful to His covenant. Record of God's dealing with men in the past confirmed this.

Let's consider some examples:

1. God's covenant with Abraham - Genesis 12:1-3
2. God's covenant with Noah - Genesis 7:9-17
3. God's covenant with David - 2 Samuel 7:16; Luke 1:31-33
4. The New Covenant - Hebrews 12:24; 13:20-22

Clearly history proved that none of these covenants of God failed. Now it is your turn, God will not fail or disappoint you in Jesus name!

### 2. Covenant people of God

*“And the king stood by a pillar, and made a covenant before the LORD, to walk after the LORD, and to keep his commandments and his testimonies and his statutes with all their heart and all their soul, to perform the words of this covenant that were written in this book. And all the people stood to the covenant.” 2 Kings 23:3*

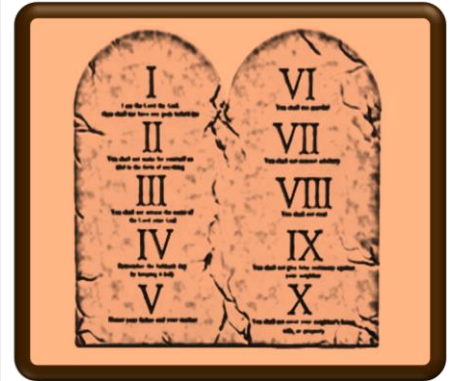
*“But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; to such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them.” Psalms 103:17-18*



God's covenant people have always been special people. In the world we find them going places and achieving what others described as difficult to achieve because their God worked with them, stood by them, worked through them and fought their battles when there are battles to fight.

Their inheritances on earth were secured and guaranteed as well as their place in the kingdom of God. These are the privileges God is offering us today as He invited us to come into covenant relationship with Him.

Covenant relationship with God is simplified to this basic fact - He wanted us to be His people and He wanted to be our God. The minimum God expects in our covenant relationship with Him is to give ourselves to Him without reservation if we are ready. He is ready too.





## ABOUT WATCHMAN OUTREACH MISSION

Watchman Outreach Mission as envisioned fundamentally comprises of men and women of faith who watch over one another and together watch for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. In the years that followed we networked with churches and other Christian groups too to implement our mandate which include conducting gospel outreaches, discipleship training for new converts, organizing and facilitating workers and ministerial training, conducting administrative reviews in churches and ministries, writing of proposals for reforms and church growth strategies that can enhance social cohesion, improve church finances and foster overall development, unity and growth of such ministries; monitoring and/or supervision of the implementation of such reforms and strategies.

Some of these Christian groups and ministries include with Christ Apostolic Church, Oke - Ife in Ajangboju, Ibadan, Nigerian Military Christian Fellowship, Adekunle Fajuyi Cantonment Chapter in Oyo - State Nigeria, Christ Gospel Mission International, Light of Jesus Evangelistic Ministry with branches in different cities in South Western Nigeria, and Ark of Salvation Church of Christ (ASCC) with headquarters at Molade, Monatan Ibadan.

Till date, although partnered ministries change from time to time depending on the leading we receive from the Lord, we remain committed to our main purpose and vision; that of service to the church and in the world to wake up men everywhere and encourage them to remain alert and watch for the Lord’s return. Through our activities, souls had been saved, believers edified and church workers’ spiritual growth and development enhanced, all to the glory of God.

# THE NEED FOR COVENANT WITH GOD/THE MAKING OF COVENANT WITH GOD

*“Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself. Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: And all the people answered together, and said, All that the LORD hath spoken we will do. And Moses returned the words of the people unto the LORD.” Exodus 19:4-5, 8.*

*“Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded.”*

## James 4:8

The world could be a very lonely place without reliable friendship and companionship. Yet, the best among men could disappoint us when we least expect. Therefore, every man needs a friend or a relationship; someone with whom our interest is 100% guaranteed. Only God can provide such friendship, relationship or guarantee. Hence, we need God by our side at all times. However, God will not take side with the wicked or those whose way of life are hurtful and injurious to others.

The principles that guides divine-human relationship demand that we come by way of

covenant if we want the best from God or a portion above that which everyone else have because the whole earth belongs to God. Exodus 19:5. God has general blessing for everyone on earth no matter their belief or religious conviction. (Matthew 5:45) But He reserved special blessings for special people. These are those in covenant relationship with Him. Genesis 17:18-21.

We shall consider two parts to this message:

1. The need for covenant with God
2. The making of covenant with God.

### 1. The need for covenant with God

- i. Covenant guarantees a future in a period of uncertainty. Genesis 28:15, 20-22
- ii. Covenant guarantees safety in times of danger Genesis 31:23-24, 29
- iii. We need a covenant with God when the mountain before us seems impossible to climb
- iv. We need covenant if and when we want to be special in God's programme. Exodus 19:4
- v. When we are haunted with fears, worries, doubts and anxiety over a plan, programme or project Genesis 15:2-4, 18.
- vi. Whenever we face threat or feel threatened by enemies' forces of darkness or adversities.
- vii. Whenever we doubt our ability or strength to succeed in any race Christian or secular

### 2. The making of Covenant with God

*“And Moses came and told the people all the words of the LORD, and all the judgments: and all the people answered with one voice, and said, All the words which the LORD hath said will we do. And he took the book of the covenant, and read in the audience of the people: and they said, All that the LORD hath said will we do, and be obedient.*

*“And Moses took the blood, and sprinkled it on the people, and said, Behold the blood of the covenant, which the LORD hath made with you concerning all these words.”*

### Exodus 24:3, 7-8.

Covenants especially covenant with God have four components -

- i. Covenant partners
- ii. Covenant document
- iii. Covenant undertaking and seals
- iv. Covenant witnesses

In the Old Testament, covenant between men or between God and man requires the shedding of blood but it is no longer necessary. The blood of Jesus is the seal of covenant of grace, also known as the New Covenant or everlasting covenant. Our part today is to pledge allegiance to God or renew that allegiance if we already had one with Him. Details of these include a pledge:

- i. To forsake sin. Proverbs 28:13
- ii. To serve God. Exodus 23:25-27
- iii. To give our best to Him. The best of our time, energy and resources. Proverbs 3:9.
- iv. To consistently obey His word. Deuteronomy 28:1, 3-7, 10.
- v. To live lives that glorifies Him everyday
- vi. Dedication of all that we are and have; and all that we will ever have and ever be.
- vii. To love Him supremely above all else and to seek to do His will always, by so doing live a life that pleases Him.

That is our commitment and consecration in Watchman Outreach Mission and the goal of our service to the Lord. We seek people who share our consecration and commitment to the Lord so that He can bestow His blessings upon us. Exodus 32:26,29. If we are ready, the Lord is ready too.



## SIGN OF COVENANT RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

*“And when Abram was ninety years old and nine, the LORD appeared to Abram, and said unto him, I am the Almighty God; walk before me, and be thou perfect. And I will make my covenant between me and thee, and will multiply thee exceedingly. This is my covenant, which ye shall keep, between me and you and thy seed after thee; Every man child among you shall be circumcised”.* **Genesis 17:1-2, 10**

Covenant relationship like contractual obligations today comes with recognizable, verifiable sign or signature. God’s covenant with Abraham and his seed was to be recognized by a physical sign; the sign of circumcision. This sign separated them from all others in the world of that time to the point that it took on a descriptive label whereby the world at that time became categorized into two; those who are circumcised and the uncircumcised. If today, we cannot find any clear-cut distinction between those who belong to God and those who do not, something is seriously wrong.

God still demands circumcision from His people today; circumcision of the heart which should result in verifiable outwardly transformed life and holy living. Abraham’s seed who rejected or ignored circumcision of the flesh is in danger of being ostracized or judged severely by God and the penalty may include death, nobody should therefore be in doubt that dirty, corrupt, immoral living and ungodliness will alienate present day nominal Christians from the kingdom of God and from Heaven. 1 Corinthians 6:9-10.

We shall consider three points:

1. Jewish outward covenant sign of symbolic circumcision
2. New Testament believers verifiable sign of spiritual circumcision

3. God-set condition for intimate relationship with Abraham’s seed

### 1. Jewish outward covenant sign of symbolic circumcision

*“And Abraham took Ishmael his son, and all that were born in his house, and all that were bought with his money, every male among the men of Abraham’s house; and circumcised the flesh of their foreskin in the selfsame day, as God had said unto him. And Abraham was ninety years old and nine, when he was circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin”* **Genesis 17:23-24**

The pains and scar of Jewish outward circumcision was to be a constant reminder that they are different from every other race in the world and thereby live their lives as God’s chosen and peculiar people. Unfortunately, a time came when in spite of the physical signs of divine ownership and consecration to Him that they bear in their bodies, in conduct; they were not different from the heathen around them. They were most often times subjected by God to the same punishment and judgment. It further necessitated the need of a new covenant as prophesied by Jeremiah – Jeremiah 4:3-4.



God recognizing that the heart of the matter is a matter of the heart. He promised to circumcise their hearts and give them a heart of flesh. This became fulfilled in the New Testament dispensation. Spiritual circumcision became the heritage of contemporary seeds of Abraham - all those who came to God through faith in Christ Jesus. Galatians 3:27-29.

### 2. New Testament believers’ verifiable sign of spiritual circumcision

The commandment given to Israel in the Old Testament to some extent regulated their behavior and actions but does not bring about any real lasting change and transformation in their lives. Real lasting change is only possible through a re-order of their intentions, thought patterns and

motives as well as acquisition of a clean, clear and sensitive conscience. The sacrifice of Christ and cleansing by His blood made this available. Today, New Testament believer can by the operation of God’s spirit in their hearts through His application of the blood of Jesus and the truth of the word of God obtain and retain purity of heart which ultimately would translate into outwardly verifiable righteous living and blameless conduct. Like the Israel of old, those who reject or neglect this work of grace and do not consecrate for it until God does it in them and for them will be rejected in the end. They shall be denied the privilege of spending eternity with Christ and with God. “Without holiness no man can see the Lord” Hebrews 12:14.

### 3. God-set condition for intimate relationship with Abraham’s seed

*“A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them”* **Ezekiel 36:26-27**

Both the Old and New Testament scriptures are united in affirmation that sin alienates men from God. Just like the Jews at that time requires outwardly verifiable mark and scar of physical circumcision as an evidence that they belong to God and have relationship with Him, believers today require circumcision of heart (purity of heart) and holiness to partake in the blessings of God’s kingdom offered here on earth but most especially in heaven. God is no respecter of persons; if God does not spare the son of Moses a special servant (Exodus 4:24-26.) then, what He has said about circumcision as prerequisite to enter heaven stands for everyone who wants to enter heaven.

*“Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:”* Hebrews 12:14

## BLESSINGS OF COVENANT RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

*“Keep therefore the words of this covenant, and do them, that ye may prosper in all that ye do. That he may establish thee today for a people unto himself, and that he may be unto thee a God, as he hath said unto thee, and as he hath sworn unto thy fathers, to Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob.” Deuteronomy 29:9, 13*

*“But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, saith the LORD, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.” Jeremiah 31:33*

Covenant making, covenant renewal and covenant relationship is one of the greatest experiences a man can have with God. Many people are afraid of covenant. With men this is wise, we should be careful entering into any covenant with any man. We must seek proper and clearer understanding of all contract before we sign. If we are not sure, we should consult a lawyer and seek advice. But with God, things are different. All He wanted and expects from us like marriage contract is “Yes, I do” and leave the rest in His hands. He is one that will give us strength, ability and grace and power to fulfill our obligations in

our covenant with Him Yet He would still bless us after we have done so.

We shall consider three subtopics:

1. Divine blessings through covenant
2. Notable examples of God’s faithfulness to His covenant
3. Future destiny of covenant people



### 1. Divine blessings through covenant

*“But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children’s children; To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them.” Psalms 103:17-18*

Blessings that come from covenant relationship with God is enormous: covenant takes our relationship with God to another level. Covenant makes us special in God’s programme. Covenant speaks for us that we mean business and desires to become serious in our relationship, commitment and dedication to God. Covenant families are special families, covenant ministries are special ministries, and covenant nations are special nations. Covenant creates exception from the common experiences, suffering, challenges that

face everyone.

Yet covenant is not different from any other process of acknowledgement of divine ownership over us, all we are and all we have; acknowledgement of our obligations to God just like everything else or everyone else in the world. The whole earth and its fullness belong to God whether we covenant our own portion of it or not; they belong to Him.

However, when we practically and personally handed them over to Him by way of covenant, we are making a statement that among the populace, we are ready to stand up and stand out. We are ready to go extra mile and indeed all the way with God. We may bring our family, businesses or work or projects and plans into it. God in turn appreciates and rewards that commitment.

*“Then will I sprinkle clean water upon you, and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you. A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them:”*

*Ezekiel 36:25-27*

## 2. Notable examples of God's faithfulness to His covenant

*"Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee: And I will make of thee a great nation, and I will bless thee, and make thy name great; and thou shalt be a blessing: And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall all families of the earth be blessed."* **Genesis 12:1-3;**

*"In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates:"* **Genesis 15:18;**

*"Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham. Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree: That the blessing of Abraham might come on the Gentiles through Jesus Christ; that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith."* **Galatians 3:7, 13-14.**

Two clear examples demonstrated God's faithfulness to His covenant and to covenant people in the world. First is the existence of the nation of Israel in the Promised Land today and the blessings of the whole world through Jesus Christ in line with God's covenant with Abraham. They are evidences that

guarantee a miracle and testimony-filled present time and a glorious future. If Abrahamic covenant is still in force and God is watching over it despite the fact that Abraham left this world years ago, how much more will God be faithful to present days covenant people who are alive today and all who joined in pledging commitment and allegiance to God in a world of increasing waywardness, ungodliness and backsliding even among church goers.

## 3. Future destiny of covenant people

*"Come, my people, enter thou into thy chambers, and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself as it were for a little moment, until the indignation be overpast."* **Isaiah 26:20**

*"Eyes have never seen, ears have never heard, neither has it entered into the heart of men, the things God has prepared for those who love Him"* **1 Corinthians 2:9.**



Pledge your love and loyalty to God today in a personal way today *"And if it seem evil unto you to serve the LORD, choose you this day whom ye will serve; whether the gods which your fathers served that were on the other side of the flood*

*or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land ye dwell: but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD. And the people answered and said, God forbid that we should forsake the LORD, to serve other gods;"* (Joshua 24:15-16) Take a covenant stand for God today and watch as great transformation from glory to glory begins in your life. It shall be so in Jesus name!

## MISSIONARY OF THE MONTH

Liu ZHENYING  
"Brother Yun"  
(1958 till date)



He quickly opened the door and standing before him were the two servants he had seen in the vision. One of them held a red bag in his hand. In this red bag was a Bible.

One morning at 4am, Brother Yun had a dream. In the dream, God asked him to be His witness in the west and south. He eventually became a witness of Christ not just in the western and southern parts of China, but throughout China and in the nations beyond China as well.

Brother Yun was arrested by security police numerous times and was thrown into prison three times for sharing the gospel in communist China. But he also has testimonies of great deliverances and miracle after miracle in his time of travails similar to those found in the Bible which helped to strengthen his faith. Some of them are written in his book "*The Heavenly man*". The book was awarded the "*Christian Book of the Year*" by the UK Christian Booksellers Convention in 2003.

Brother Yun eventually escaped from China and sought asylum in Germany in 2001. Since then, he has been continuing his ministry from there and has spoken to congregations internationally. He founded "*Back to Jerusalem*". The Movement has been sending missionaries out from China to share the gospel in least-reached nations. He is married to Deling, with whom he has two children.

### SCRIPTURE FOR MEDITATION

*"But as it says in the holy writings, things which the eye saw not, and which had not come to the ears or into the heart of man, such things as God has made ready for those who have love for him." 1 Cor.2:9 (BBE)*

Liu Zhenying, popularly known as "*Brother Yun*" worldwide, was born in February 1958 in the province of Henan in China. He became a believer at the age of 16. Brother Yun was born into a poor family. His family's financial situation took a turn for the worst when in 1974 his father became ill with an asthmatic condition that led to lung cancer eventually. His mother, who had been a Christian for many years but had become spiritually cold after the expulsion of Western missionaries during the Cultural Revolution, felt a deep sense of desperation because if her husband had died then, it would leave the family in dire straits. She thought of committing suicide. One evening, as she was lying in bed, she heard a voice saying to her that Jesus loved her. In tears and in repentance, she rededicated her life to God and gathered her family to pray for her husband. The next morning, her husband got better and as a result, everyone in the family, including Brother Yun, put their faith in God.

Soon after, he started hungering for the Word of God. However, his family did not have a Bible. He began asking his mother who Jesus was. His mother told him that Jesus was the Son of God and that His teachings are all recorded in the Bible. Brother Yun decided to fast and pray for a Bible. For the next 100 days, he ate only one bowl of steamed rice every day. One day at 4am, after fasting for 100 days, he saw a vision. In the vision, he was walking up a steep hill and saw an old man pulling a large cart of fresh bread. The old man asked him if he was hungry. He said 'yes' and started crying.
